PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and abusive language, and will refrain from their use at all sports events.
- I will focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than on winning or losing.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of their race, gender, creed, or ability.
- I will remember that children participate in youth sports for their own enjoyment and will respect this.
- I understand that my player's primary team takes precedence over any team on which my player is asked to play. My player will only play for another team if asked, if granted permission by the primary team's coach, and if there is no conflict with my player's primary team.
- I will remember that children learn best by example and will appreciate good performances and plays by all participants.
- I will demonstrate positive sideline behavior and never "coach" from the sideline.
- I will respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- I will ensure that my child will be available for all activities.
- I understand my child is committed to the entire 10-month season (August-June).
- I understand that parents are not allowed to be on the fields during practice unless expressly invited by the coaching staff.
- I will abide by the "24 hour rule", i.e., I will not contact a coach within 24 hours after a game to discuss issues.

SPECTATORS' CODE OF FAIR PLAY

- Remember that young people participate for their benefit and enjoyment – not yours.
- Applaud good performances and efforts from all participants and teams.
- Congratulate all participants on their performance regardless of the game's outcome.
- Respect the decisions of officials and teach the players to do the same.
- Never ridicule or scold a player for making a mistake. Positive comments are motivational.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form – whether by players, coaches, officials, or spectators.
- Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them, there would be no game.
- Encourage the players to follow the rules and to respect the officials' decisions.
- Do not use foul language or harass coaches, players, and officials.
- Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of every young person regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability.

Everyone present at FC814 Events are held to this Code of Conduct. Refusal to follow this Code of Conduct will result in dismissal from FC814 Events. The spectators are the responsibility of the parent and player!

1st Offense will result in a 2 week suspension from FC814 Events – any event in which the club is participating.

2nd Offense is a season long suspension from FC814 Events.

3rd Offense results in a decision from Exec Board if player should be allowed to play in club and minimum 3 year ban for the Parent/Spectator.
